

Boxing SA Athletes & Coach Selection Document

To ensure a clear direction on Selection for Athletes and Coaches to Boxing South Australia (BSA) State teams the follow selection document has been developed.

Athletes

1. Must be registered with BSA.
2. Elite Open Male Boxers must be registered with Office Recreation and Sport and complete the MRI and medical requirements.
3. Continuously nominating for competition and taking matches when made available. No activity no selection.
4. Attend State trainings / camps.
5. Respect all other Athletes, Official and Coaches during competition and trainings.
6. If you cannot attend a training or camp, you must notify the State Coach providing the reason why.
7. BSA Athletes entered any competition by Boxing Australia Limited (BAL) will comply with the requirements set out in this selection document and contribute to the BSA team in a positive respectful manner.
8. Dress appropriately in state or club uniforms, no uniforms / clothing with in-appropriate writing will be acceptable. If representing the State and you have a State uniform it must be worn unless approved by the Team Manager or Head Coach.
9. Comply with all directions / policies provided from Boxing SA. Boxing SA Committee reserves the right to make amendments when necessary to direction / and policy.
10. When selected for a BSA team deposits and final payments must be made by the due dates or you will be removed from the team.
11. The BSA selection panel will consist of the appointed State Coaches.
12. This selection document will underpin all BSA selection event criteria released.
13. Comply with the BOXING AUSTRALIA LIMITED ANTI-DOPING REGULATIONS.
14. Comply with the BOXING AUSTRALIA Board Statement on COVID-19 vaccination and Boxing Australia National Activities.
15. Comply with the BOXING AUSTRALIA LIMITED ANTI-MATCH-FIXING REGULATIONS.
16. Comply with the BOXING AUSTRALIA LIMITED SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY.
17. Comply with the BOXING AUSTRALIA LIMITED REGULATIONS REGARDING PROHIBITED CONDUCT.
18. Comply with the BOXING AUSTRALIA LIMITED PARTICIPANT PROTECTION REGULATIONS.
19. Comply with the BOXING AUSTRALIA TECHNICAL AND COMPETITION REGULATION.

Coaches

1. Must be registered with BSA.
2. Attend State trainings / camps when invited or when available being active and working with the athletes.
3. Attend BSA tournaments and build relationships.
4. Respect all Athletes, Official and Coaches during competition and trainings.
5. If you can't attend a training or camp, you must notify the State Coach.
6. Dress appropriately in state or club uniforms, no uniforms / clothing with in-appropriate writing will be acceptable. If representing the State and you have a State uniform it must be worn unless approved by the Team Manager or Head Coach.
7. Comply with all directions / policies provided from Boxing SA. Boxing SA Committee reserves the right to make amendments when necessary to direction / and policy.
8. When selected for a BSA team deposits and final payments must be made by the due dates or you will be removed from the team.
9. Comply with the BOXING AUSTRALIA LIMITED ANTI-MATCH-FIXING REGULATIONS.
10. Comply with the National Integrity Framework
11. Comply with the BOXING AUSTRALIA Board Statement on COVID-19 vaccination and Boxing Australia National Activities.
